Leveraging the Fifth Day for Learning in Rural Colorado

"Every day counts when it comes to the learning and the future of our students, and that's what Leveraging the Fifth Day grant and pilot is all about.

Four-day school weeks are becoming more common across the western United States, including in 88 of

Colorado's 179 school districts. Some shorten the week to save money or to meet community needs or aide in teacher hiring and retention. But there's an opportunity in that fifth day. The Donnell-Kay Foundation visited many communities on a four day school week and decided investing in the 5th day might help grow authentic learning from the ground-up.

Monte Vista Kids Connection from Monte Vista School District, East Otero School District, and Campo School District RE-2 are three of the eight finalists in the Donnell-Kay Foundation's Leveraging the 5th Day grant and pilot.

The eight communities including our own three communities came to Denver and went through an eight hour design thinking workshop and are now back in their communities implementing empathy and user centered design strategies, such as student interviews, stakeholder meetings, and community asset mapping." - Antonio Pares, Donnell-Kay Foundation
