Mental Health Workforce in Rural Colorado

The Center for Rural School Health & Education (CRSHE) at the University of Denver established a partnership with Southeast BOCES, Santa Fe Trail BOCES, and Colorado Rural Education Collaborative to develop a robust school mental health workforce in rural Colorado. With grant funding from the Colorado Department of Higher Education, we hosted an immersion program for graduate students enrolled in school psychology and school counseling programs. In total, seven graduate students from the University of Colorado Colorado Springs, University of Nebraska - Omaha, and Texas Woman's University joined us for a one week experience.

Teacher Leader Efficacy

The "Math Mentors" Grant is in full swing!

SC BOCES, GSN, and UCCS, with the support of a Plan Into Action Grant from CDHE, have partnered to develop a mentoring infrastructure to increase the capacity of in-service teachers to mentor early career teachers and pre-service teachers.

Both veteran and novice teachers meet monthly in a virtual PLC where they participate in low-floor, high-ceiling math tasks (with discussion of how to begin implementing and integrating such tasks in their classroom), collaborate on how to use data to inform instruction, and share strategies for addressing new teacher concerns.
