#### **College and Career Readiness**

Generation Schools Network continues to work alongside the Santa Fe Trail (SFT) BOCES (6 districts), partners Battelle for Kids and Ogallala Commons through the Colorado Rural Education Collaborative to develop the Pathway to Prosperity Project in

the SFT BOCES. You can see the SFT Pathway to Prosperity <u>here</u> which aims to expand college and career readiness programming for students in the SFT BOCES. During this past spring semester, GSN worked with partners to hold the first of three North Star meetings aimed at building a consensus around the most essential skills that students should develop as part of this program. The second North Star meeting will take place in late summer and will include strategies to improve online/remote learning for the fall semester.
