

We interviewed rural innovator Michael Lamond from Salida Middle School about the threepart project he did with his students inspired by the book A Long Walk to Water by Linda Sue Park. Lamond had his students read the book and do a "Water Walk," carrying 5 gallons of water up Tenderfoot Mountain. They also raised more than \$7,000 for wells in Sudan! Lamond constructed this project to show his students the perspective of those who do not have accessible water nearby in their country. Rather than being a product provided by a tech vendor, the project uses the EdFi standard to support grassroots Colorado Rural Education Collaborative (CREC) efforts across districts in reporting out to their local communities in support of their vision to achieve equitable, studentcentered teaching and learning.
