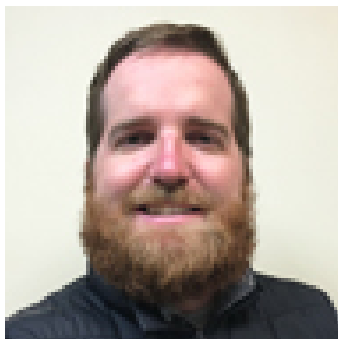


I-76 Partner Convening
